

Joe Holland Construction Well Underway

Construction on the 50,000 square foot Joe Holland Chevrolet and Imports Parts and Service Center is on schedule according to construction manager Sheldon Evans. "Trades are working well together to complete the project on time," Evans said.

The building, located on D Street, is of pre-engineered metal construction and will be home to 45 service bays upon completion.

This new facility will move the existing service center from the current MacCorkle Avenue location freeing up the current space for additional upgrades ac-

ording to Joey Holland. "It's all about our customers," he said.



"Access and dropoff will be improved and the waiting areas have been upgraded. With the addition of new service bays, waiting time will also decrease," said Holland. He added, "We're just grateful that FMC worked with us to make this property available for our expansion."
